

Permits shall be required for all non-exempt types of open burning within all areas of Sheridan County, including but not limited to, agricultural burning for the purpose of crop management; fires set for demonstration purposes by government or industrial personnel in fire-fighting procedures, including vacant buildings, and the on-site burning associated with land clearing operations, crop or game management practices or construction projects.

Prior to any such burning, the dispatcher at the Sheridan County Sheriff's office at 785.675.3481 shall be notified of the intent to burn. Information concerning the burn location, including specific burn travel directions, approximate beginning time and approximate length of burn shall be given to the dispatcher at the time of notification. In the event the fire is not started within one (1) hour of the estimated time, no open burning shall take place on that day until proper and further notice be given to the Sheridan County Sheriff's office.
