

## Kansas State Regulations for Open Burning- Clarification

This is to clarify the provisions of section 28-19-647 (e) of the Kansas Regulations for Open Burning.

These provisions apply only to open burning activities that require approval from Kansas Dept. of Health and Environment, such as city and/or county tree and brush burning sites. They do not apply to agricultural burning activities, such as rangeland and CRP burning.

Although the section (e) regulations don't apply to agricultural burning, they are still highly recommended practices. They address safety, smoke and pollution issues that should be of equal concern to those burning agricultural land.
